About the Teachers Warehouse

The Teachers Warehouse serves teachers in public schools grades k-6. The mission of The Warehouse is to serve the educational and creative needs of children in South Central Indiana by providing a unique means to transfer donated merchandise from businesses and individuals free of charge to teachers for use in their classrooms and schools.

Sadly, many students in our community cannot afford basic school supplies. In the classroom, books and other supplies can be scarce or nonexistent. Teacher must use personal funds to obtain necessary supplies that parents and strained school budgets cannot provide. Meanwhile, every business in South Central Indiana routinely discards surplus office supplies, books, arts & crafts materials, containers, organizing bins and more.

The concept is simple: The Teachers Warehouse gathers these surplus items from businesses and individuals and offers them at no charge to area school teachers for use in their classrooms.

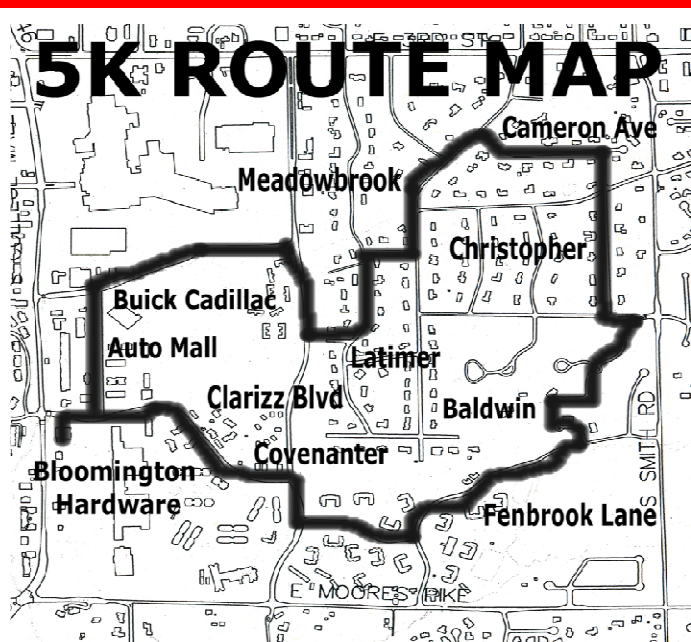
